2705. To accept Minutes of the previous meeting:

It was **RESOLVED** to accept the minutes of the meeting held on 1st March 2023 and they were duly signed.

2706. To discuss Matters Arising:

2623c Recreation Ground Fencing is ongoing.

2630b Toddlers Play Area: Cllr Tuitt is concerned about the tar mac which is lifting and grass is coming through which could form a trip hazard. It apparently needs attention every couple of years. Cllr Moss agreed to speak to Neil at Redlynch and ask them to come back and check it out. Redlynch have been e.mailed and photos sent. This is ongoing.

Redlynch don't seem to want to come out. But Cllr Tuitt has pushed on the health & safety angle. Cllr Hinson will put something together so it can be sent to Redlynch. It was felt that the surface wasn't resurfaced properly.

2707. Open Forum - Residents requests to Speak:

Anything residents wish to discuss must be sent to the Chairman/Clerk at least 3 days before the meeting. A maximum of two minutes will be allowed per item. The item will only be discussed once at the meeting and must be relevant to Parish Council business. (Residents have been advised previously of what the PC has no restriction over ie rear access roads, private gardens etc).

Although the recent clean-up was carried out at short notice, it went very well.

It was noted that CBC have put locks on the bins.

CBC are proposing to put a recycling bin by the hall. This will be for clothing, books and shoes. They will empty every week and keep it tidy. The contract needs to be checked by the Village Hall Committee and ensure it is only a smallish bin.

Sounded like Shots being fired at 11.30pm last night from the buildings – Cllr Hinson will report to Steve Haddock as this is illegal.

Downpipe back of Highfield Crescent privately installed. Facing out onto the footpath, it would discharge onto public footpath. It is on private land but discharging on to public highway which is an offence. Cllr Tuitt agreed to report it to Report to Highways.
